DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A canvas anchor packer was set at 4125 - tubing perf. below the packer. The packer succeeded in shutting off all water and 1000 gallons acid followed by 45 bbls oil were pumped down tbg. On official proration test after acidization the well flowed at a rate of 3630 bbls oil per day thru tbg., and was awarded an open flow potential of 4925 bbls oil per day.
