DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated this well with 1000 gallons acid pumped in to pay formation from 4151' to 4215' with 800# pressure. Loaded hole with 200 bbls oil and chased acid with 66 barrels oil. Permitted well to remain shut in for 48 hours and then commenced producing well normally thru 28/64" choke. Flowed well normally for ten days and then tested well for potential and received a potential of 9800 barrels, off curve. Effective March 16th, 1934, daily allowance was increased to 207 barrels.
