

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL NEW WELL

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector and approval obtained before drilling begins. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in triplicate. One copy will be returned following approval.

Dear Sir: You are hereby notified that it is our intention to commence the drilling of a well to be known as **Clara Fowler** Well No. **2** in **N 1/4** of Sec. **31** T. **18**, R. **36**, N. M. P. M., **Hobbs** Oil Field _____ County

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about **2000'** feet.

Additional information:

Note: The 9-5/8" casing to be set and cemented at approximately 2750', and it is our intention to drill through this gas-producing formation using heavy rotary mud to hold back this heavy gas pressure. When the 7" casing is set and cemented and well completed this gas will be shut off completely.
