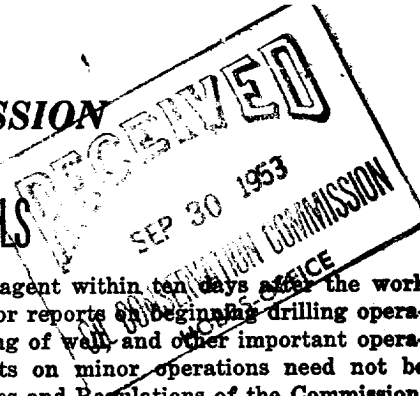

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Bottom hole pressure was measured at -400 datum after 48 hours shut-in. Pressure observed to be 1087 psi. A slight leak was observed in the braden head at a shut-in pressure of 600 psi. Temperature survey was conducted while well was static, an anomaly was found to exist between 2700' and 3100'. Braden head was opened and well produced approximately 50 MCF when stabilized. We plan to take remedial steps as outlined on the attached Form C-102 when approved.
