

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

We pulled tubing and set a bridging plug at 3897'. Casing was perforated with two 1/2" holes at 2860'. Cemented with 350 sacks. Top of cement was found to be 2345'. After waiting 44 hours for cement to set, the plug was drilled out below the perforations. Casing was swabbed dry and perforations tested. Shut off tested OK. The bridging plug was drilled out, tubing run back into hole and well put back to producing.
