DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above described well was re-treated with 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid solution below packer set at 4050' through 3" tubing and followed with 63 Bbls. of oil. The following results were obtained:

The Potential of the well from below packer was raised from 1,500 to 3,500 Bbls. per day which is an increase of 2,000 Bbls. The gas-oil ratio was raised from 1930 Cu.Ft. to 2750 Cu.Ft.
