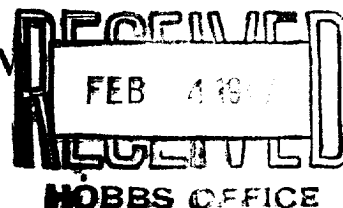

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3164' Total Depth, Correction 3170' equals 3164', also 5 1/2" Casing was set at 3164' instead of 3170'. Ran Lane Wells Gamma Ray Survey 1400' to 3162', and perforated Casing with 6 shots from 3149 1/2' to 3150 1/2', put on xmas tree, and ran 102 joints of 2" EUE 4.7#, H-40, R-2, SS Tubing with 3' perforated nipple on bottom bull plugged, and tubing set at 3140', rigged up to swab and swabbed well in and opened up at 1AM and flowed for 6 hours 1/4" Choke and made no fluid and flowed at the rate of 1,383M cu. ft. gas per day. Will squeeze off perforations and perforated Casing lower.
