Following is a notice of intention to do certain work as described below at the Gulf Oil Corporation
Gypsy Production Divn - West Grimes Lease Well No. 1-9 incl in West half
Company or Operator Lease (8 producing wells & 1 gas well)
of Sec. 32, T. 18, R. 38, N. M. P. M., Hobbs Field,
Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION
Present condition of the two tank batteries follows:

North Tank Battery - 1060' E of W line and 745' S of N Line, Sec 32-18-38.

One steel receiving tank, one 6' Nat'l heater, one 16x16 wood treating tank, and four low 500 bbl bolted steel stock tanks. The receiving tank and heater are in good condition but the stock tanks are badly corroded and must be replaced this year.

South Tank Battery - located in C of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 32-18-38.

One flow treater, one 10x16 wood treating tank, and three 22x10 wood stock tanks. The flow treater which serves as separator and heater in this system is beyond repair and must be replaced this summer. Replacement of the treater would require the setting of a receiving tank and new heater.

Viewing the immediate need for replacement of the treating sys on the S battery and of steel stock tanks on the N. battery; we propose to move the three wood stock tanks from the S. battery, add one additional tank from another lease in the field, and set separators, treating heater, and receiving tank from the N. battery at a point approximately 100' N of the Center of section 32-18-38.

To put our lease oil treating and stock facilities in proper condition with a minimum requirement of new materials, we therefore request your permission to produce wells 1,2,3,5,6,7,8 and 9 into one tank battery centralized as outlined.
