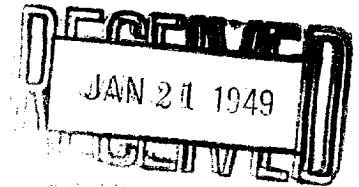

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After waiting forty-eight hours, the casing was tested with 1000# pressure applied for 30 minutes. The upper plug was drilled and the casing and cement were tested with 1000# pressure applied for 30 minutes. The lower plug was drilled and the casing and cement were tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes. All tests were OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil & Gas Inspector, preparations are being made to complete the well.
