FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On January 16, 1949, ran 130 joints of new 7" OD, 8 Rd Thd, 23#, J-55, R-2, SS csg. Tallies 4087', H-12', set @ 4099', w/4 7" Weatherford csg centralizers spaced @ 3632', 3688', 3755', and 4090'. Cemented by Halliburton w/700 sacks of 2% and 125 sacks of neat bulk cement. Plug @ 4070'. Found top of cement back of 7" csg @ 2150' per temperature survey. Perforated 7" csg w/one 1/2" hole by McCullough at 2100'. Re-cemented 7" csg w/500 sacks 2% aquagel and 100 sacks neat cement by Halliburton. Pump plug to 2040'. Job started @ 5:40 p.m. and completed @ 6:35 p.m., January 17, 1949.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off @ 6:35 p.m., January 19, 1949.

Cement back of 7" csg @ 1450' per temperature survey, after csg had been re-cemented.
