DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Before workover the subject well was flowing a daily penalized allowable of 22 bbls. oil with 3 bbls. water thru 12/64" choke with a gas-oil ratio of 3,265 cubic feet per barrel.

In an attempt to reduce gas-oil ratio and increase production the well was deepened from 4174' to a total depth of 4243' and 321' of 5" OD liner set on bottom, using 3 centralizers, 90 sacks cement and 10 sacks Stratocrete. 5" OD liner was perforated from 4193-4217' and from 4225-4233'.

After workover, the well flowed 585 bbls. oil, no water in 24 hours, thru 3/4" choke on 2 1/2" tubing. 783 MCF gas. GOR 1339.
