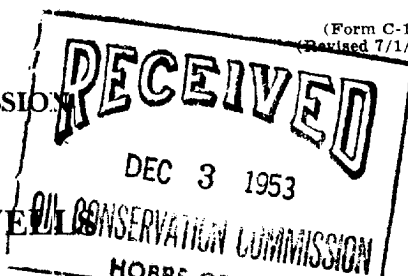

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled 3" tubing and packer. Squeezed hole in 7" casing at 524' with 25 sacks cement. Squeezed series of holes in 7" casing from 1116' to 1176'. Deepened to 4234'. Ran radioactivity log. Set 5" OD Liner at 4232', cemented with 50 sacks. Top liner at 3871'. Perforated liner with 4 jet holes per foot; 4181-4194'; 4200-4209'. Ran 2" tubing with packer set at 4106'. Tubing bottomed at 4199'.

Flowed 148 bbls. oil, no water, in 15 3/4 hrs. through 26/64" choke on 2" tubing for 24 hr. potential of 225 bbls. oil, TP 560#, GP 0# (Packer) GOR 1003, Gravity 33°.
