NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State A 33 Lease
Well No. 4 in S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 33, T. 18S, R. 38E,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on Sept. 25 1931 15 1/2 - 70 lb. casing was ~~XXXXX~~ { cemented } in Red rock
formation at a depth of 232 feet on Sept. 25 1931
425 sacks of El Toro Com. & El Toro Spl. cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

200 sacks by Halliburton method and 225 sacks dumped on outside of casing to surface, to properly protect surface water from foreign matter and pollution.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of _____ feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
