387 sacks of El Toro Com. & El Toro Spl. cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: 286 sacks pumped in casing by Halliburton method and 101 sacks dumped on outside of casing, filling to the surface, to properly protect surface water from foreign matter and pollution
