NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in **State A 33 Lease**
Well No. **7** in **NE** of Sec. **33**, T. **18 South**, R. **38 East**,
N. M. P. M., **Hobbs** Oil Field **Lea** County,
on **January 10,** 19 **33** **7" O.D. 24** lb. casing was ~~lined~~ cemented in **Shale & Lime**
formation at a depth of **3970** feet on **January 4,** 19 **33**
350 sacks of **El Toro** cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: **Pumped in by Halliburton Method.**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of **3986'** feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: **Gypsy Oil Company and Landreth Production Company.**

Additional information: **Of the cement used, 225 sacks were El Toro Common and 125 sacks of El Toro Special Oil Well Cement.**


