NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

on **December 16,** 19 **32** **9 5/8"40** lb. casing was ~~XXXX~~ { cemented { in **Anhydrite**
formation at a depth of **2756** feet on **December 10,** 19 **32**
600 sacks of **El Toro** cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: **400 sacks of Common and 200 sacks of special Oil Well Cement were pumped in by Halliburton Method.**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of **2756** feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
