NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State A 33 Lease.
Well No. 7 in NE 1/4 of Sec. 33, T. 18 South, R. 38 East,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on December 1, 1932 15 1/2" lb. casing was ~~cut~~ cemented { in Red bed
formation at a depth of 237' feet on November 20th 1932
250 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: 235 sacks were pumped in by Halliburton method and 15 sacks were poured in cellar around the above mentioned string of pipe.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 237' feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Landreth Prod. Corp. and Gypsy Oil Co. on 11-30-32

Additional information: Of the above mentioned cement used in cementing this string of pipe, 75 were Special oil well cement and 175 sacks were common cement.
