On 9-14-48 you approved our application to drill the subject well on which was stated that 10 3/4" casing would be set at 360'. Due to shortage of pipe it is necessary that we use 13 3/8" casing instead of 10 3/4"

Well has been drilled to 363' redbed. On 9-15-48, 13 3/8" casing was set at 362' with 300 sacks cement, using 2 centralizers. Cement will be allowed to set for 24 hours, after which time test for water shut-off will be made.
