I also note on this well that the only reports you have filed during drilling operations were Form C-103s on testing the 10 3/4" and 5 1/2" casing. I refer you to Order 4, Rule 26 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission. This rule states that Form C-102 shall be filed with the Commission before any casing is tested. We will appreciate your doing this in the future.

As soon as you file Form C-105 on this well the Authorization to Transport Oil will then be in order for approval.
