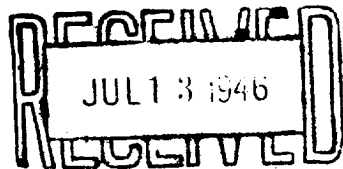

Gulf Oil Corporation East Grimes Well No. 3 in the
Company or Operator LeaseNE/4 of Sec. 33, T. 18 S, R. 38 E, N. M. P. M.,
Hobbs Field, Lea County.

The dates of this work were as follows: Cemented 5 1/2" July 1; tested July 4, 1946

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Tested 5 1/2" casing on July 4, 1946. Hole was washed down and the casing tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes. The plug was drilled and the hole tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes. Both tests were OK, and the well was swabbed and put on production. On July 9, 1946, well tested 249 barrels pipe line oil in 13 1/2 hours through 30/64" choke.

This was a work over job to replace corroded tubing and repair casing leak in the old 7" string by running new 5 1/2" casing.
