Work-over job. Pulled the 3" and 1 1/2" tubing. Found 7" oil string corroded and leaking. Ran new 5-1/2" National Grade H-40 SS casing, set at 4086' cemented with 75 sacks Trinity Portland regular cement by Halliburton. Plug pumped to 4072.

Cemented 5-1/2" casing on July 1, 1946; propose to drill plug and test shut-off on July 4, 1946.
