Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Landroth Production Corporation Well No. 38 in the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 COMPANY OR OPERATOR 33 LEASE 18 of Sec. 18A, R. 105, N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field, 3/10/34 County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated well with ~~2500~~ 1500 gallons of Dowell XX Acid. Rated potential of well before treatment was 9461 barrels, 20 Million of gas, and with a gas/oil ratio producing the daily allowable oil of 1200 cu. ft. per barrel.

After treatment the well tested at the rate of 12,442 barrels of oil with 38 million cu. ft. of gas, and the gas/oil ratio on the regular daily allowable declined to 945 cu. ft. per barrel.
