## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was killed with water and a 10' Guiberson Spiral Oakum Packer was set at 4025' (-391'). An effective shut-off of Zone I water was made. Results of subsequent tests have indicated large quantities of water in Zone II which are being removed by use of swab. It is believed that water from Zone I had, before setting packer, saturated formation in Zone II around well bore to such an extent that efforts to remove water by swab will be continued. Well is now flowing intermittently after swabbing but dies due to presence of water. Results of subsequent tests will be forwarded as soon as well has been satisfactorily put on production.
