FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On July 7, 1949, at 12:01 a.m., 48 hours will have elapsed since running 3151' or 5 1/2" casing set at 3160', and cemented with 700 sacks to be used as oil string. At this time it is planned to test pipe and water shut off by applying 1000 PSI pressure and holding for 30 minutes, before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 PSI occurs on either test, proper remedial measures will be carried out. In the event the above tests satisfactorily meet requirements, drilling will then be resumed.
