

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 15, 1946, at 4:00 p.m., 48-hours had elapsed since running 4224' 5½" OD 14# H-40 Casing in subject well and cementing with 300 sacks to be used as oil string. At this time casing shut off was tested in the following manner:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes after which cement plug was drilled, and again a 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes. These tests were OK, and completion operations were resumed.
