DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 7:30 A.M., on August 9th, 1947, 30 hours had elapsed since running 5 1/2" O.D. new 14# casing and setting at 4211 feet, cementing with 800 sacks cement, to be used as oil string. At the time mentioned, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes. This test was OK. Cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK, and completion of repair operations continued.
