FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On September 1, 1949, at 6:00 p.m. 48 hours will have elapsed since running 3202' of 5 1/2" casing set at 3191' with 800 sacks to be used as oil string. Cement will be circulated to surface. Pipe and water shut off will be tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for thirty minutes before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 psi occurs on either test proper remedial measures will be carried out. If tests are satisfactory drilling will be resumed.
