## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On August 28, 1949 at 4:00 a.m. 36 hours will have elapsed since running 353' of 9 5/8" casing set at 361' and cemented with 250 sacks to be used as surface string. Pipe and water shut off will be tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for thirty minutes before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 psi occurs on either test proper remedial measures will be carried out. Cement will be circulated to surface. If tests are satisfactory drilling will be resumed.
