FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Propose to deepen well from present T.D. of 4185' to 4222' then perforate the present 7" oil string at 3200' and squeeze 75 sacks cement through perforations. Will let set 36 hours then drill cement and test perforations. Will then run string 5" OD casing, set at 4221' and cement to surface. Will let set 48 hours and then drill cement to shoe and test. If shut-off tests OK, propose to perforate 5" casing opposite the second and third Hobbs pay zones and produce through perforations.

Halliburton process shall be used on all cementing jobs.
