NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in *B. H. Lunn*

Well No. 1 in N/4 of Sec. 34, T. 18 S, R. 38 E,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on August 21, 19 32 9-54 lb. casing was ~~cemented~~ { cemented } in Anhydrite
formation at a depth of 2700 feet on August 17 19 32
400 sacks of El Toro Portland cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Process under pressure with pump and plug.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of _____ feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: **Shell Petroleum Corporation and Mid-West Refining Company were notified verbally.**

Condition of hole at time of running and cementing 9" casing was in very good shape and survey showed it to be only 0.2 degree off vertical.
