NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in  
Well No. 1 in NW/4 of Sec. 34, T. 18S, R. 58E,  
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,  
on July 18, 1932 12-1/2"-50 lb. casing was ~~filled~~ cemented in Red beds  
formation at a depth of 222' feet on July 18, 1932  
200 sacks of El Toro Portland cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

**Cemented through 12-1/2" with Halliburton Process.**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 222' feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
