NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in J. H. Turner
Well No. 2 in E/2 of NE/4 Sec. 34, T. 18N, R. 30E,
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on May 16, 1934 19 12-1/2" - 50 lb. casing was ~~reamed~~ cemented in Red Bed
formation at a depth of 247' feet on May 16, 1934 19
175 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: -

Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company plug used with pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 247' feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
