NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in B. H. Turner  
Well No. 2 in NE/4 of Sec. 24, T. 18S, R. 30E,  
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field 200 County,  
on June 9, 1934 19 7" OD 24 lb. casing will be cemented { in Limo  
formation at a depth of 4025' feet on 19  
350 sacks of El Toro cement will be used cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

**Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company will be used, the plug method under pressure.**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 4025 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Stanolind and Shell are being notified by a copy of this report.

Additional information:

**Aquagel laden mud will be circulated for several hours before pipe is run so as to insure complete saturation and sealing of formations above casing point.**
