INSTRUCTIONS

This form shall be secured and filed in OIL FIELD DISTRICT Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each oil or gas produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each unit to transport oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy retained by the producer, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover a change of ownership of the unit and each change in the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary transporter in the transporter involving less than the allowable deduction for temporary transporters, the operator shall file of filing a new certificate notifying the Oil Conservation Commission, District Office, and the transporter, authorized by certificate of the Commission, of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be transported by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the name of the temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished to the temporary transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line or pipeline and authorizes the transport of oil and gas from the property named thereon and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- (a) Operating ownership changes;
- (b) The transporter is changed or
- (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, explain under the heading "REMARKS."

In all cases where this certificate is filed to cover a change in ownership, the transporter designated to move oil or gas from the unit under "REMARKS" shall be the transporter, owner or operator, and the transporter shall be authorized to transport oil or gas.

A copy of this form shall be filed in the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission.
