David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. ("Arrington"), PO Box 2071, Midland, Texas 79702, has conducted a geological and engineering review of the captioned well and determined that the Queen formation has potential for gas production. A gas well at this depth requires a 160-acre spacing unit. As you are aware, this lease is located on the extreme eastern edge of Lea County, against the Texas State Line. All the available acreage for a spacing unit in the SE/4 of Section 29 is 51.95 acres. Arrington has been in communication with legal counsel concerning filing an application for a non-standard spacing unit. A copy of that letter is enclosed.

Arrington is in the process of filing a sundry notice for the work-over in the Queen sand at approximately 3900', filing an application for a non-standard proration unit with the OCD in Santa Fe, and notifying offset operators.

Arrington therefore requests an extension for the work-over of the captioned well until the OCD grants an approved non-standard spacing unit order and sufficient time to commence operations on said well. It is Arrington's intention to commence operations as soon as practical after receiving an approved order.
