Drilled 13-3/8" hole to a total depth of 1888' and ran 1865' of 10-3/4", 32 lb., 8 RT casing. Cemented casing with 850 sacks (600 sx. 6% gel and 250 sx. neat) cement. Cement circulated. Pumped cement plug down at 11:00 A.M., 11-2-51. Will let cement set 24 hours and test for casing shut off at 11:00 A.M. 11-3-51.
