DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 140 Jts & Cut Jt. 4405.85' of 5-1/2" OD 14# J-55 R-2 ST&C SS Casing with 3 Weatherford centralizers & 13 scratchers from 4419' to 4269'. Set & cemented at 4419' with 1800 sacks 4% Gel and 50 sacks Neat on bottom. Plug at 4353'. Max. pressure 1500#. Temperature survey after 8 hours by Gulf. Top cement at 819'.

After waiting over 36 hours tested 5-1/2" casing with 800# for 30 min. No drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 4353' to 4420'. Tested cement below casing shoe with 600# for 30 min, no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to complete well.
