DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The subject well was drilled to 6525' in lime. While going in hole with bit, the drill string was stuck at 3080' and every attempt to free the string failed. Drill collars were shot off and attempts to fish for same failed. Since drill stem tests and sample analysis had failed to indicate any show of oil or gas, we plugged and abandoned the above well as follows:

A 50 sack cement plug was spotted below the base of salt at 2950'; filled with heavy mud and spotted a 50 sack cement plug to extend above top of salt at 1850'. Remainder of hole was filled with heavy mud and a 10 sack plug placed in top of hole, with a 4" marker set as provided in the rules & regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.
