FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The subject well was drilled to a total depth of 6525' in Lime. While going in the hole with bit, the drill string was stuck at 3080' and every attempt to free drill pipe and collars failed. Drill pipe was then shot-off above drill collars at 2550'. All attempts to fish out drill collars failed, and since drill stem tests and sample analysis^{had} failed to indicate any show of oil or gas, we propose to plug and abandon subject well as follows:

Spot a 50 sack cement plug below base of salt at 2950'; fill with heavy mud and spot a 50 sack cement plug to extend^{above} to top of salt at 1850'. Remainder of hole to be filled with heavy mud and a 10 sack plug will be placed to surface. A 4" marker will be placed to conform with New Mexico Commission rules.
