## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On January 6, 1952 at 10:12 P.M., 48 hours had elapsed since running 484' of 9-5/8" new casing landed at 494 and cementing with 350 sacks circulated to surface. Casing shut off was tested to 1000 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug. There was no appreciable drop in pressure and the test was considered satisfactory. Drilling operations have been resumed.
