INSTRUCTIONS

This form shall be executed and filed in QUADREPUBLICAN with the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each transportation unit to transport oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the producer, one copy returned to the producer, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operation of a unit or each change in the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary transporter involving less than the allowable production for one period, the operator shall in lieu of filing a new certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office, and the transporter authorized by certificate of the Oil Conservation Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the name of the temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished to the transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and for the transportation of oil and gas from the property named therein and shall be in full force and effect until

- (a) Operating ownership changes
- (a) The transporter is changed or
- (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, such non-compliance shall be stated in the heading "REMARKS."

In all cases where this certificate is filed to cover a change in operation or a change in the transporter designated to move oil or gas, the operator shall in the "REMARKS" the previous owner or operator and the transporter authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each producing unit approved by the Oil Conservation Commission.
