DETAILS OF WORK

As per our telephone conversation of Dec. 1, 1947 we ran 596 feet of 45 Lb. 10 3/4" Casing and mudded same with 35 sax to shut off surface water. We bailed hole dry and after testing found water to be completely shut-off and hole dry. We resumed drilling operations. We intend to pull this casing after running our string of 8 5/8" casing at about 1000'.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
