DETAILS OF WORK

Cleaned this well out to total depth of 4230' with cable tools. On 6-23-52 ran Atlas Corp Gamma Ray Survey and Gamma Ray instrument hung up and pulled out of pipe without. Fished with cable tools until 7-25-52 and then moved in Beckman, Inc. Reverse Circulation Unit and on 7-26-52 drilled well deeper from 4230' to 4307' in white lime, in order to let instrument fall in rat hole. Then commenced fishing and trying to knock Gamma Ray instrument into rat hole and on 8-11-52 fish was recovered. Well was placed on Gas Injection on 9-10-52. Production before workover was 12 BWB.

Continuing conversation with Mr. James Hanzf, U.S.G.S., Artesia, New Mexico on 7-23-52.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
