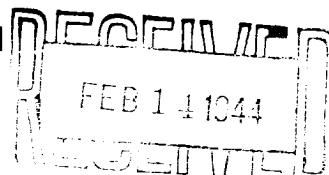

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 4267' - 1-12-44 w/ gravel from 4262-4267', ran 222 qts SNE from 4262-4127', gravel tamp from 4127'-4110' and calseal tamp from 4110'-4045' and loaded hole above with 90 bbls oil. Completed cleaning out 2-8-44, ran 2" USE Sals tubing to 4261', swabbed 9 hrs and well began natural flow, flowing 90 bbls oil load and 145 bbls net oil in 38 hours.
