5-1/2" 17# casing was cemented at 4687' with 125 sacks on October 6, 1948. Plug was pumped down at 2:00 P.M. Total depth of hole was 4689'.

We propose to allow cement a minimum set time of 72 hours. We will then enter hole with cable tools and bail out all fluid to test casing. If cement job proves to be satisfactory we will drill plug, then drill in with cable tools.
