Dear Mr. Wise:

This office is in receipt of your letter of June 3, 1993. Your letter advises that the W & W Oil, Inc. is seeking permission to store crude from two San Andres wells in tanks that are "off-lease". It is our understanding that Well No. 1 is located in Unit P; 440 FSL; 440 FEL; Section 4-17S-34E and Well No. 4 is located in Unit I; 2030 FSL; 660 FEL; Section 4-17S-34E.

From your request it is our understanding that all rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Division have been complied with, and there will be no comminglings with oil from other sources. Furthermore, that the State of New Mexico will suffer no loss as a result of your proposed operation. The Commissioner of Public Lands on this date does hereby approve your request for off-lease storage of crude from the San Andres formation in the Miller State Unit. Final approval is subject to confirmation by the Oil Conservation Division.
