- (1). Remedied liner perforations (4207 - 4220') with 3500 gallons 20% L.S.T. acid.
- (2). Returned to production by swabbing and flowing.
- (3). Flowed 82 barrels oil and 35 barrels water (30%) through a 20/64-inch choke in 24 hours. Flowing tubing pressure 75 p.s.i. Increased production 43 barrels oil per day.
