## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Deepened hole from 4185 to 4216. Ran 5 1/2-inch flush joint liner from 3916 to 4215 and cemented with 125 sacks cement. Drilled out to 4210. Perforated liner from 4158 to 4208 with 4 shots per foot. Treated with 500 gallons acid and set packer at 3850. Swabbed well in. Flowed 127 barrels oil cut 3/10 per cent water in 24 hours through 10/64-inch choke. Tubing pressure 425 pounds. Gas oil ratio 831.
