DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

This well has been acidized w/2000 gallons. After treatment the well flowed at an average rate of 107 bbls. oil per hr. To give the well a potential commensurate with adjacent wells, it is proposed to acidize with 6000 gallons of acid.

The well will be circulated with hot acid until the returns indicate that the temperature of the hole is uniform. The acid will then be pumped down tbg. and followed with sufficient oil to place the acid beyond the zone of reaction of the first treatment.
