Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas inspector if possible.

Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Shell Petroleum Corp. B. H. Turner Well No. 1 in the SW 1/4, NE 1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 18-S, R. 38-E N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field, Lea County.

The dates of this work were as follows: Well treated w/2000 gallons hot acid on April 10th 1935 Notice of intention to do the work was (was not) submitted on April 10th 1935 & tested 4-12-35 and approval of the proposed plan was (was not) obtained. (Cross out incorrect words.)

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was circulated with hot oil initial temperature of which was 142 degrees Fahr. until the returning oil attained a temperature of 120 degrees F. 2000 gallons acid at a temp. of 118 degrees F. was then gravified down tbg. The acid was flushed from tubing & hole with 40 barrels of oil.

Before treating this well flowed at an average rate of 30 bbls oil per hr. thru 3" tbg for a 13 hr. period. After acidizing the well flowed at a rate of 107 bbls per hr thru 3" tbg for a period of 2 hrs.
